Who can enter PVNA art contest?

Children and young people aged 2-16 who live in Picfair Village. The categories for entries are in four age groups: Ages 2-5, 6-8, 9-12, and 13-16. Final eligibility will be decided exclusively by the PVNA.

What kind of art can I enter?

Any art technique can be used to create entries, including painting, drawing, collage, crayon, sculpture and even finger painting! (Oh, and don't forget you can use recycled materials too! Judges like that!)

How do I enter the PVNA art contest?

Fill out the official submission form and up to three pictures of your artwork and send them to Daveriva@aol.com - between May 4th and May 30, 2025. You can even submit a short video of your artwork coming to life! (See instructions.)

When will results be announced?

All artwork will be reviewed by our judges and the victors will be announced on the Picfair Village website (PicfairVillage.com) on June 30, 2025, along with images of their art for all to see. Winners will also have their art displayed in the PVNA Public Kiosk (on a rotating basis) and will have a public viewing at a local location, TBD.

Please be sure that your visual entry does not exceed 11"x17" or sculpture no more than 10"x10"x10"!

Terms & Conditions of Entry

The Picfair Village 2025 Youth art competition is run by Picfair Village Neighborhood Association (PVNA). Submissions are open from May 4-30, 2025. **No entries will be accepted after the deadline.**

Each entry must comprise of work undertaken by a child/young person aged between 2 and 16 years old and submitted by the deadline date of May 30th, 2025. Entries will be judged separately. The following are the age categories to be judged: aged 2-5, aged 6-8, aged 9-12 and aged 13-16.

All entries must interpret the PVNA 2025 theme of “**Something I like about my Neighborhood.**”

All entries must be received digitally by midnight on Friday, May 30th, 2025. Send all entries to the PVNA Vice-President, DaveRiva@aol.com via Email, WeTransfer, Google Drive or Dropbox. ALL submissions must have the Entrant(s) name in the file name and in the header of the email. No physical artwork should be sent to PVNA until needed for the public showing event when/if announced. We will contact the entrant(s) directly at that time. Be sure your contact information is correct and legible!

Permission from each entrant’s parent/legal guardian must be sought and obtained to enter the competition.

Each individual entry must comprise of:

- i. A fully completed individual entry form, signed by the entrant’s responsible adult aged over 18.
- ii. Up to 3 photographs of the artwork.

In addition to the above, an accompanying video can be submitted (not required) to show the artwork and/or creative processes. Specific conditions for a video submission are:

- i. Videos can be a maximum of one minute in length.
- ii. Videos must be submitted by email or via WeTransfer, Google Drive or Dropbox to Daveriva@aol.com. Entries must have the artist’s name in the file name and in

the subject line of the email. Videos are accepted in MP4 format with landscape the preferred option.

- iii. Please ensure the video is of a high resolution and the audio clear. All video should aim to show the artwork and how it was created.
- iv. All videos must respect copyright law. You must have written permission for any content used in the film that is not your own and must be prepared to supply these permissions to PVNA if requested.
- v. PVNA may ask to use your video in the online final or for other promotional purposes. If so, PVNA will require a model release form for everyone visible in the film. This will be downloadable from the PVNA website or will be sent to entrants at the time of the request.
- vi. **All video footage must only include age-appropriate content and imagery.**

Entrant agrees that submitted photographs or videos of any entry may be used in the PVNA virtual contest announcements, Public viewing event(s), on the PVNA website, PVNA social media pages and PVNA emails. These permissions are automatically granted by the entrant(s) if any entry is submitted.

Please note that we may use your name (first name and only first initial of surname), age and street name of residence for the purpose of identifying you as the creator of your entry.

Eligible entries will be judged on the quality of art, interpretation of the theme, and creativity. All the decisions of the PVNA judges will be final. Any entry can be removed from consideration by the PVNA Judges for any reason and at any time.

PVNA reserves the right to cancel the PVNA art contest 2025 competition entirely, should circumstances arise out of their control that make it necessary.
