Call to Order - Board Roll Call:

Meeting called to order at 6:05 p.m. Inclusive of Board and guests, 11 attendees. Minutes from March 2026 PVNA General Meeting were approved.

Item 1: Reports

A. Council District 10 Field Representative Mayra Guevara

- Mayra has met with the Business Owner/Property Owner of Hollywood Auto on Hauser and Venice. The owner understands the ongoing issues and has been told he can no longer do mechanic work outside the boundaries of the business. He understands that he cannot park vehicles on the street or on the median. It has been made clear that the city needs to see progress. There will be a follow up meeting in May, wherein all the violation should be handled. Continue to use 311 to report issues.
- In response to questions about speed bumps and stop signs, Mayra can call on the Department of Transportation for a traffic studies. Joe Carrabba will send Mayra an emails with the corners that have been mentioned in the meeting, including Ellesmere/Saturn and Ogden/Airdrome. Also mentioned was the foliage blockage in front of stop signs. (311 report)
- Mayra reminded the group that if having a block party, the correct forms must be completed.

B. LAPD Senior Lead Officer (SLO) Dantzler

- The Wilshire Division carnival was successful.
- The Neighborhood Walk with a Cop had a great turn out. Gratitude was expressed to the neighborhood and especially to Monique Carrabba for getting the word out.
- Over the past 30 days there was 1 aggravated assault, 1 robbery and 3 burglaries from motor vehicles.
- There will be Wilshire Division catalytic conversation etching event. More information TBD.
- If anyone is interested in getting further involved, the CPAB (Community Police Advisory Board) is an available avenue for involvement. This is a monthly meeting held at the Wilshire Division offices on Venice.
- There have been some altercations with the person who lives in their care on Orange Grove. The altercations fall under the auspices of the Department of Mental Health. If there are issues with unhoused residents, please reach out to LA HOP, Roger Estrada and Mayra Guevera.
